Have you attended an APICS CSCP certification review course but have not passed the exam?

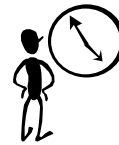


Did you “self-study” but did not pass the exam and need motivation to help you get going again?

APICS and the Twin Cities Chapter strongly encourage you to complete your APICS CSCP designation **this year**. There is only **ONE** test window remaining before significant updates are made to the CSCP Learning System and the exam:

April 7 – May 19, 2012

Time is running out. This is your last chance to take the CSCP exam using materials published in 2011 or before. APICS CSCP material underwent a significant update for 2012. If you miss this exam window, you will need to spend additional time studying and cross referencing the information contained in the 2011 and 2012 materials.



The Twin Cities Chapter is offering a one day CSCP refresher course for students who attended a CSCP course between spring of 2009 and fall of 2011. Self-study students, who purchased a Learning System between spring 2009 and spring 2011, are also eligible to attend with prior instructor approval.

The class will be held on **Tuesday, April 3, 2012**, from 8:30am to 4:30 pm at Dunwoody College of Technology in Minneapolis. You will bring your Learning System and the instructor will address the updates that have taken place since 2009 to get you up to speed with the 2011 materials.

Payment must accompany registration:

- Registrations received **after March 20, 2012**: APICS members: \$275; Non-members: \$325
- Final Registration deadline is **March 27, 2012**.
